

2018 STATEWIDE CAMPOUT SKILL-A-RAMA REQUIREMENTS

The 2018 Statewide Skill-a-Rama will consist of 5 test centers. Each boy will be asked four questions at each test center. Each question will be worth 25 points for a total of 100 points per test center. The maximum total number of points that can be scored by each boy will be 500 points (5 test centers times 100 points max. per test center). There will be no half points or partial points awarded for each question. Each boy will score 25 or zero points for each question. All boys scoring a total of 375 points (75%) or more will earn a Skill-A-Rama patch.

The four test questions will be selected from the set of 10 questions for each test center. Your Statewide Campout packet has the 10 questions for each test center. The four test questions each boy will be asked will be taken from the list of 10 questions for each test center. The five test centers will be Bible; Tool Craft/Rope Craft; Safety/First Aid; Fire Craft/Cooking; and Miscellaneous.

Each test center will have a coordinator and at least 3 leaders

Bible – Skill-A-Rama Possible Questions (2018)

1. Recite: Romans 3:23.
2. Name three things a person should do after becoming a Christian.
3. Recite Matthew 7:12.
4. Which book of the bible has the 10 commandments listed?
5. What are the four main teachings (cardinal doctrines) of the church?
6. Recite Revelation 3:20.
7. Name the first 2 books of the bible.
8. What was the name of the giant that David killed with his sling shot?
9. What are the four phases of a boy's development (4 gold points)?
10. Name the first four books of the New Testament (four gospels).

Tool craft /Rope craft– Skill-A-Rama Possible Questions (2018)

1. Demonstrate how to pass a sheath knife.
2. Tie a Square Knot.
3. Demonstrate how to open and close a pocketknife.
4. Demonstrate and explain how to sharpen a knife.
5. What is the safest tool for cutting campfire wood?
6. What knot is called the "King of Knots"?
7. Name 3 tools that can be used to cut firewood.
8. Name four commonly used hand tools.
9. Name three tools used on a camp-out and how they could be used.
10. What knot do you start lashing with and what knot do you finish lashing with?

Safety/First Aid– Skill-A-Rama Possible Questions (2018)

1. Why should you wear gloves when using a bow saw?
2. Why is it important to define a “cut and chop” area in your camp site?
3. What should you do if the small boat you are in capsizes?
4. What is the proper First-aid when you come in contact with poisonous plants?
5. Name the 2 pieces of safety equipment you should have on your bike.
6. Explain why and how cuts and scratches should be cared for.
7. What is the proper First-aid for simple burns?
8. Explain under what circumstances a person should not be moved.
9. Explain and demonstrate First-aid for a minor cut.
10. Name at least four items that should be in a good First-aid kit.

Fire craft/Cooking– Skill-A-Rama Possible Questions (2018)

1. Name three ways to start a fire.
2. Explain how to put a fire out.
3. Name three different kinds of fires that can be built.
4. Explain the advantages of a Tepee Fire.
5. Name two different cooking methods.
6. Name three things you would find in a good cook kit.
7. How should you dispose of your garbage when camping?
8. Demonstrate how to build a “Log Cabin” fire.
9. Explain the advantages to using an “A Frame” to start a fire.
10. Explain the steps necessary to properly wash dishes.

Miscellaneous – Skill-A-Rama Possible Questions (2018)

1. Recite the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. Flag.
2. Recite the Royal Ranger pledge.
3. Name four different kinds of insects common in Minnesota.
4. Recite John 3:16.
5. Identify and name animals (from picture) common to Minnesota.
6. Name 4 different kinds of birds that are common to Minnesota.
7. What is the name of the Minnesota State bird?
8. Name four different kinds of trees that grow in Minnesota.
9. Recite the pledge to the Christian flag.
10. Identify and name (from picture) tree leaves common to Minnesota.
