Cooking Equipment: consider your menus carefully keeping in mind what you will need to prepare them and how many people will be eating. Please plan for 2-3 extra guests each meal.

- Aluminum foil
- Burnable Paper Plates & Bowls
- Can opener
- Coffee pot
- Cooking & Serving utensils for grilling and cooking over a camp fire
- Dish rags & scrubbers
- Drinking cups
- Eating utensils
- Garbage bags & Trash containers
- Knives
- Matches for starting fires
- Measuring cups
- Paper towels
- Pots & Pans
- Spices for your recipes
- Sticks for roasting marshmallows
- Tub to wash dishes in

Camping Equipment

- Camp stove with fuel
- Camp tables
- Cooler/Ice chest
- Dining fly
- First aid kit
- Gas lantern with extra mantels
- Heavy wire grill
- Rake
- Rope & twine
- Small broom
- Small shovel for fire control
- Tents with ground cloth
- Water jugs for cooking & drinking
- Water pails for fire control

Personal Items

- Bible
- Bug spray
- Sun block
- Rain poncho/boots
- Clothes for Sat. & Sun.
- Flashlight with batteries
- Money for Critter Shack & Missions Offering
- Personal hygiene items
- Pillow
- Sleeping mat for under sleeping bag (keeps moisture & cold air from coming from the ground)
- Something to sit on during services
- Towel/washcloth/soap
- Warm clothes for outside evening services: gloves, hat, jacket etc.
- Warm PJ's (including clean undies)
- Warm sleeping bag (no slumber bags)
