Pre-camp

1. Pray for all campers, volunteers and Evangelists.
2. Need to have their own camera and video editing equipment
3. Read and understand the Camp Volunteer Manual.

4. Create a 30 second “promo” video that can be used for the following year. The new logo will be added later. Make it capable of being uploaded to YouTube.
5. Help with crowd control in the Worship Center during all services as well as Halftime (counselor break).
