PURPOSE OF THIS CAMP

This camp will focus on marching, learning drill and ceremony as well as the basics in carrying and presenting our flags. You will learn the importance of teamwork, discipline and uniformity at this camp.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Royal Rangers who have with written permission from their parents and:

1. Completed grade 6 and up
2. Boys must have successfully completed Junior Training Camp
3. Have earned the Gold Eagle Medal or Bronze Medal of Achievement

MEDICAL EXAMINATION

Your son must be in good health to participate in the strenuous activities of the training camp. Therefore, it is required that he has a physical examination. After the examination, please sign the following statement, “after consultation with child’s physician, I know of no physical reason that would restrict my son from participating in camp activities” on the camp application.

In addition, please fill out the Minnesota District Royal Ranger Activity Emergency Medical Information and Authorization Form and bring to the camp with you.

REGISTRATION FEE

A \$25 non-refundable fee must accompany this application. The registration cost is \$175 if received by July 1st, and \$225 by July 14 and \$250 after July 15. This fee includes all the meals, the Honor Guard beret and the special Honor Guard equipment that will be kept by the Honor Guard graduate. If for any reason you are unable to attend the camp, you must notify Todd Wille District Training Coordinator TWO WEEKS prior to the camp to receive a refund.
